President's Report ~ Connie "Jean" Ribbeck



Another hot summer is here. I am so happy that Ameraucanas are heat tolerant! I don't think I have filled more waterers daily in any other year. I am getting anxious about what I may have to show at this year's National in Great Falls, MT. I have a couple promising silver pullets with minimal shafting I received from John Blehm. I also have a couple white pullets and a black cockerel that all hatched in March that are looking good. The rest of the birds are younger and still have a bit of growing and feathering in left to do.

My chocolate project birds are coming along nicely. It is just going to take time to keep breeding back to black to improve type and egg color a few more generations. I have just started the silver laced project to produce silver laced birds and to try to improve lacing on blues. All the chicks hatched out looking like extended black bantam chicks. I was not able to start with the large fowl this year as the silver laced Wyandotte pullet I had didn't make it.

My goal this year was to replace older pullets in my blue/black, buff and wheaten/blue wheaten pens. I think I hatched around 400+ chicks this year. I ended up losing several to "piling" the first week they were outside and then a few more to cocci when we had a week of rain. I am considering trying the cocci vaccine next year to prevent losses. I am also thinking of dividing up the grow out area into sections so that the chicks cannot all go in the same corner. In Club news, I would like to thank John Blehm for stepping up to take over our Secretary/Treasurer position. This will be an "interim" position until our next election in the fall of 2014. Michael needed to step down to devote all his time to his family. I would also like to thank Michael for all the work he has done for the Club and let him know our thoughts and prayers are with him. He has been a valuable asset to our Club and he will be missed as a member of the Board of Directors.

The Rocky Mountain Poultry Association is hosting our National October 5, 2013 in Great Falls, MT. They are donating \$50.00 to Champion Ameraucana and \$25.00 to Reserve Champion Ameraucana. They are also donating \$1.00 back to the Club for each Ameraucana entered in the show. We are also having our Western District Meet at the same time. Judges scheduled are Dave Anderson, Sam Brush and Jeannette Frank.

White Ameraucanas were also a force to be reckoned with in the Junior division. Alexis Parker won BB with her white pullet and Austin Parker won RB with his white pullet. Alexis also went on to win Champion AOSB in the Junior division.

In the Open Bantam class, Ralph Malys won BV with a lavender cockerel and RV with a lavender pullet. There were no bantams shown in the Junior division. Judging the classes this year were Daniel Dysart, Glenn See, and Curtis Oakes.

The six birds I took to the Canfield show now have new homes in NY, OH, & PA. I would like to thank those who purchased them and hope to see them, and those birds, at shows in the future. North Central District Report ~ Duane Schroeder, Director



After record heat in the summer of 2012, the Midwest has experienced cooler than normal temperatures this summer. Since more chickens typically are lost to the heat than to the cold, this has been a welcome change.

This spring I hatched out 49 LF Wheaten/Blue Wheatens. As soon as I could be certain to identify male vs. female, I culled 11 of the males. The goal now is to select the few I will show in October and the 2 quads I will overwinter to perpetuate my flock. Raising the WBS variety is challenging. Regardless of the quality of your breeders, the percentages of offspring that are of show

quality tend to be low. This is a reflection of the fact they are a relatively new variety having just been accepted in the APA in 1984.

I receive frequent calls and emails inquiring about my Ameraucanas. It seems interest in our breed is rising at a fast pace, but we still have a way to go in educating others about how they differ from Easter Eggers. I've often thought about how wealthy Jean would be if she had a dollar for every time she's written "EE" in an on-line forum!

South Central District Report ~ Paul Smith, Director



Greetings from the South-Central District.

Hatching season is finally over for us, and everyone in the SC district that I have had contact. This is a year to remember. It started with very low hatch rates, delayed chick shipping and ended with a two week extension of hatch season for us. I blame the weather for the hen's delayed egg production. It was constantly changing from cold to warm then back to cold early in the hatching season. It

frosted several times in April and even into May 2nd. Here in North Texas the cold is suppose to be over March 25! Once the hens started laying, fertility was very low at first. Later in the season, they started hatching very well yielding 200 chicks per hatch which enabled us to fill all chick orders except two that were cancelled. One family had a tree to fall on their house during a storm and the other cancellation wanted their chicks earlier than we could supply them, as the orders are filled as they were received. Two more of the early shipped orders were shorted a few wheaten chicks and reimbursed for the shortage. We sent a total of 966 chicks in 49 boxes and had 114 more picked-up here.

We only kept 220 here for a total of 1300 hatched in 2013. We added one state to make 41 now that we have sent our Ameraucanas.

Hope everyone has a successful growing season and develops some Ameraucanas into champions to show this fall. Any ABC member desiring a meet in the SC district needs to let me know. The New Mexico State meet at Four Corners Poultry Show; Texas State meet at Ft. Worth Livestock Show; a special meet at Bluebonnet Classic; Louisiana State meet and special meet at the Gulf Coast Poultry Fanciers double show are in the process of being booked for Ameraucana meets.
